INSTRUCTIONS TO CONTRIBUTORS

1. Submission of Papers: All authors are requested to submit their original manuscript and figures with two copies (three sets in total) to the Office of Fukushima Journal of Medical Science, Fukushima Medical University Library, 1 Hikariga-oka, Fukushima City, Fukushima, 960-1297, Japan. Tel: +81-24-547-1682, Fax: +81-24-547-1996. Electronic manuscript submission is also available. Please submit your file in PDF format to the Office at f-igaku@fmu.ac.jp.

2. Manuscript Preparation

Manuscripts must be written in English, double-spaced with wide margins on one side of A4 paper. Original Articles are divided into the following sections: Abstract (approximately 200 words), Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion, Acknowledgements, References and Figure Legends. The sections of Review Articles and Case Reports can be changed. The title page must comprise (1) the title, (2) the full-names of all authors, (3) their institutions, (4) running head (not exceeding 45 characters including spaces), (5) keywords (5 or less), and (6) the mailing address of the corresponding author including telephone and FAX numbers and e-mail address. An electronic copy of the paper should accompany the final version.

References should be given in the following form:

Photographs must be supplied as they are reproduced, a scale should be marked on the photograph, if necessary. Color figures will be charged to the author.

Tables should be numbered serially and given a suitable title and each table typed on a separate sheet. Footnotes to tables should be typed below the table.

3. Ethics: All studies that involve human subjects must abide by Ethical Principles for Medical Research Involving Human Subjects, the Declaration of Helsinki (http://www.wma.net/e/policy/17-c_e.html).

4. Page charge and reprints: The page is charge ¥ 4,000 per printed page. Reprints can be ordered at actual cost. Articles requested by the Editor will be printed free of charge.

5. The copyright of the articles published in the Journal is transferred from the authors to the Publisher, the Editorial Office of The Fukushima Society of Medical Science, upon acceptance of the manuscript.
